**15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:**

Jesus gave his apostles the power and the authority to speak and to act in His name. They drive out demons, anoint the sick, and speak of the good news of the word of God. Jesus also sends us to proclaim the good news of God in and through our work with others. God has a plan for each of us, and it is better than our own plan. As long as we trust in God, our needs will be met. God wants us to be dependent on him and not on ourselves.
