How do I register? You must pre-register for VIRTUS online. No walk-ins can be admitted. Go to Virtus.org and follow the prompts. Please provide your title (Mr., Mrs., Ms., Miss), full name as it appears on your driver's license, complete address, phone number, email address, last 4 digits of your social security number and the community in which you will be volunteering. Be sure to arrive fifteen minutes ahead of your session. Space is limited. If you cannot make St. Martin's VIRTUS training session, please go to virtus.org and sign up for another parish. Please be advised that "Protecting God's Children" Awareness Session is emotionally powerful and therefore, ***attendees must be out of high school and over the age of 18.***

Now that I am registered for a VIRTUS training session, what is next? The Archdiocese of Cincinnati requires that all volunteers and staff who work with children must take part in a VIRTUS Protecting God's Children Awareness Session ***and*** a background check through SELECTION.com.
