Congratulations to SMOT alumnus **Alex Dickey** (Class of 2010) on a great season with the Cincinnati Steam Baseball Team. The Cincinnati Steam is a collegiate summer baseball club that competes in the Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League, which is one of eight leagues formed under the National Alliance of College Summer Baseball. Alex started playing baseball at the age of five here at St. Martin. He went on to play two years of varsity baseball at La Salle High School. He is currently starting his junior year at Wabash College where he has been a relief pitcher. This summer, Alex played his first season with the Cincinnati Steam. While he was on the mound, they turned their first ever triple play in the team's 11 year history!
