

For the fall of 2020 in response to the Covid-19 Pandemic

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Introduction

Teamwork

Levels of the Plan

Our plan is made up of four levels that can be implemented throughout the school year, depending on how things proceed. We are sharing both with you so you are familiar with the steps being taken this year. Decisions regarding levels will be determined jointly by the Parish and School staffs and communicated to our families immediately.

Inherent Risk

Even with our best efforts, the risk of contracting the Covid-19 virus is possible. By coming to school, there is an accepted risk involved. Our Family/Student Handbook will be updated to include a statement of risk that is assumed by coming to school during a pandemic. While risk remains, there is greater detriment to our students' overall development by remaining at home. In-person learning is the best way for our students to succeed overall.
